

#### Memories of Thelma Hinkle

It's surprising to me that Thelma and my friendship existed only for the past few years, since we met in class at the Blaisdell Y. After running into the back of a school bus at the age of 96 Thelma decided to give up driving her car. But Thelma had been coming several days a week to senior classes at the Y for years, for decades! Now how was she going to continue to attend classes? Several of us who live nearby volunteered to pick up Thelma at her home, drive her to the Y, and return her to her front door. Every time I drove her she repeatedly expressed her appreciation to me and to the other drivers for accommodating her.

During our car rides I got to know Thelma better. She reminisced about when she and her husband, Frank, moved to Minneapolis from Chicago in the mid 1955's, buying their first home on 5th Ave., where she lived until her death. They had two sons, Richard and Frank Jr.

Thelma recalled her longstanding job working in customer service at the Sears store in Eden Prairie. She prided herself on always arriving for work on time.

Family friends, the Martin sisters, Kelly and Karen, were a regular part of Thelma's life. Thelma knew their mother and recalled when the twin sisters were born. Kelly's home is across the street from Thelma. She and Karen cared for Thelma like daughters, checking on her well being and attending to her daily needs. Thursdays they made weekly grocery shopping trips to Cub Foods. Sundays they drove to attend services at Greater Friendship Missionary Baptist Church.

Eventually Kelly began bringing Thelma to the Monday ForeverWell Classic class, setting up her chair and keeping an eye on her during class.



During the summer of 2022 the Y sponsored hikes at metro-wide parks, called "Unlock-it". When Blaisdell hosted the hike at Powderhorn Park, Thelma and I went to the park together. She enjoyed visiting with Y members from other metro branches, drinking complimentary Caribou coffee, while others of us walked around the park.

Thelma joined the ForeverWell members when we went to Minnehaha Falls to enjoy lunch outdoors at picnic tables.






She had a lot of fun during the Coffee Chat outing to the 5-8 Club, home of the Juicy Lucy.
