It's hard for me to believe that our first women's sharing group was two years ago! Sandra Freeman often gives me credit for being instrumental in forming the group but without her it never would have started! I am an introvert and always feel unsure of myself while she exudes confidence and admits to being an extrovert. I do love how it has grown and blossomed.

During Covid when we were all feeling so isolated, I found the Coffee Chat through the YMCA app. Although it originated from the Blaisdell Y and I participated mainly at the Eagan YMCA, I was quickly accepted as a member of the group. It was wonderful to get to meet a whole new group of friends from various walks of life, see their smiling faces on zoom and get to participate in conversations about the isolation we were experiencing as well as talk about life in general. I very much looked forward to those weekly chats and rarely missed a week.

A year or so later Sandra asked if I would like to meet her for coffee. We met at Turtle Bread and the time just flew by as we talked about our lives. A quick and easy friendship developed which happily has continued to grow over the years. We were both struck by how full each others lives were, all the adventures we've had, things the other person had accomplished or experienced that was surprising or inspirational and the many ways the journeys in life draw us together. That day we both realized that simply having someone to talk to who truly listened gave us such joy. It was a joy that we wanted to share with other women. Certainly not that men wouldn't also benefit from some close conversations but acknowledging that women don't speak as freely with men present, that as women we sometimes feel things as much as we hear or see them. Come and listen, speak when you are moved to do so and know that you are always among friends. We discuss our lives, family or health challenges. We are always willing to listen when someone is having a rough day or facing something they would like another opinion on.

As I've gotten older many of my friends have moved or drifted away, sadly some have died. It has been such a blessing to meet this amazing group of women who are interesting and interested in such a wide variety of things. I continue to attend the zoom coffee chat when ever possible as well as women's sharing. I make my way down to the Blaisdell Y for movies, classes, game day and special events whenever I can. I feel so lucky to have so many new friends! You have opened my mind and I so appreciate all your stories. You have all shown me how to see the blessings my own life holds.
