SAFETY AROUND WATER!

This program is offered to students ages 4-12 who are taught two benchmark skills.

Swim, float, swim– A child who has entered the water can swim to safety, and if needed, turn on their back to float and rest, then turn back over and resume swimming.

Jump, push, turn, grab – If a child were to fall into the water, they can push off the bottom, turn around, and grab onto the side or wall for safety.

What is YIG?

The program starts in the fall when students in grades 8-12 join or form a YIG delegation at their school or community organization.

Delegations meet regularly to learn about state government, practice skills, select a program area, and prepare for the conference. High school students will choose to serve as legislators, judges, attorneys, lobbyists, media representatives, or cabinet members. Eighth grade students participate as members of the Leadership Corps where they experience and explore all of the YIG program areas.

At the end of October, delegates from all over the state attend an in-person pre-conference training event called LAUNCH to help prepare for the four-day conference in January.

On Thursday, January 9, 2025 to Sunday, January 12, 2025, delegations from across Minnesota and Western Wisconsin will come together at the Hilton Hotel in downtown Minneapolis and the Minnesota State Capitol to convene the 71st annual Minnesota
