



Health Coach Training & Development Program

Consider becoming a board-certified coach

Funded by Penny and Bill George, and The George Family Foundation, the Health Coach Training & Development Program provides training for 30 multicultural individuals who want to become National Board-Certified Health & Wellness Coaches (NBC-HWCs).

Seven individuals will be selected to participate in this year's training and development. To financially support each participant's commitment to success, program funding includes:

- Full tuition for a virtual 20-week, NBHWC-approved health coach training program
- Compensation for class time and homework
- Compensation for 50 coaching sessions required after training to be eligible for the NBHWC certification exam



Who is eligible to apply for the program:

The minimum eligibility requirements are that an applicant:

- Is 18 years of age or older
- Must identify as multicultural (i.e., race, ethnicity/heritage/culture, national origin/ birthplace, first language, LGBTQ+)
- Has at least an associate degree OR 60 college credits OR 4,000 hours of work experience in any field (i.e., approximately 2 years full-time)
