At the Y of the North, we have nine Camping and Adventure locations that provide a wide variety of programming year-round. PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITIES

We have a wide variety of programming that can be featured as the main event or added onto your experience at camp! Our teams are trained to lead valuable experiences that we hope your group will appreciate and remember for years to come.

GATHERING SPACES

Gather at one of our unique camp locations for your next school trip, work meeting, special event, or family gathering! Options vary by location, but may include outdoor pavilions and amphitheaters, indoor conference and meeting rooms, large indoor gathering spaces suited towards large groups and events, and more! Camp staff can typically accommodate setup requests and basic audio/visual equipment in many of these spaces with advance notice.

OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS

Many of our camp locations have overnight lodging available. Accommodations vary by camp with regard to building size, number of beds, amenities, and levels of rusticity. These options may include private or shared rooms in larger group lodges, as well as beds in communal, shared cabins.

MEAL SERVICES

Most of our residential camp locations are able to offer meal service for a portion or all of your visit. Our kitchen team works with you and our program leaders to ensure that food is age-appropriate and that dietary restrictions can be accommodated.



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PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITIES

SCHOOL RETREATS

We provide a range of customizable programming for school groups between our sites. Some are focused on Outdoor Learning Programs, which are educational and curriculum-based activities that help build awareness, knowledge, and skills for students to understand their connection to the environment. We also provide programming for schools that is focused on team building, getting kids outside and interacting with nature, and having fun as a group! Each site that provides programming for schools will work with you to find the programming that suits your group's goals.

GROUP TEAM BUILDING INITIATIVES

Initiatives are a series of ground-based challenges that encourage creative problem solving, critical thinking, and perceived risk-taking. These programs encourage participants to also develop greater awareness of personal choice, effective communication, trust, and teamwork.

HIGH CHALLENGE COURSE ELEMENTS

Our High Challenge Course Elements are off the ground, climbing-based activities that encourage participants to develop an inclusive mindset for all abilities with an emphasis on personal challenge, teamwork, and character development.

HORSE PROGRAMMING

Whether you are an experienced rider or just starting, we have plenty of opportunities for you to spend time on and around horses — including group rides, retreats, classes, and horseback riding lessons.
