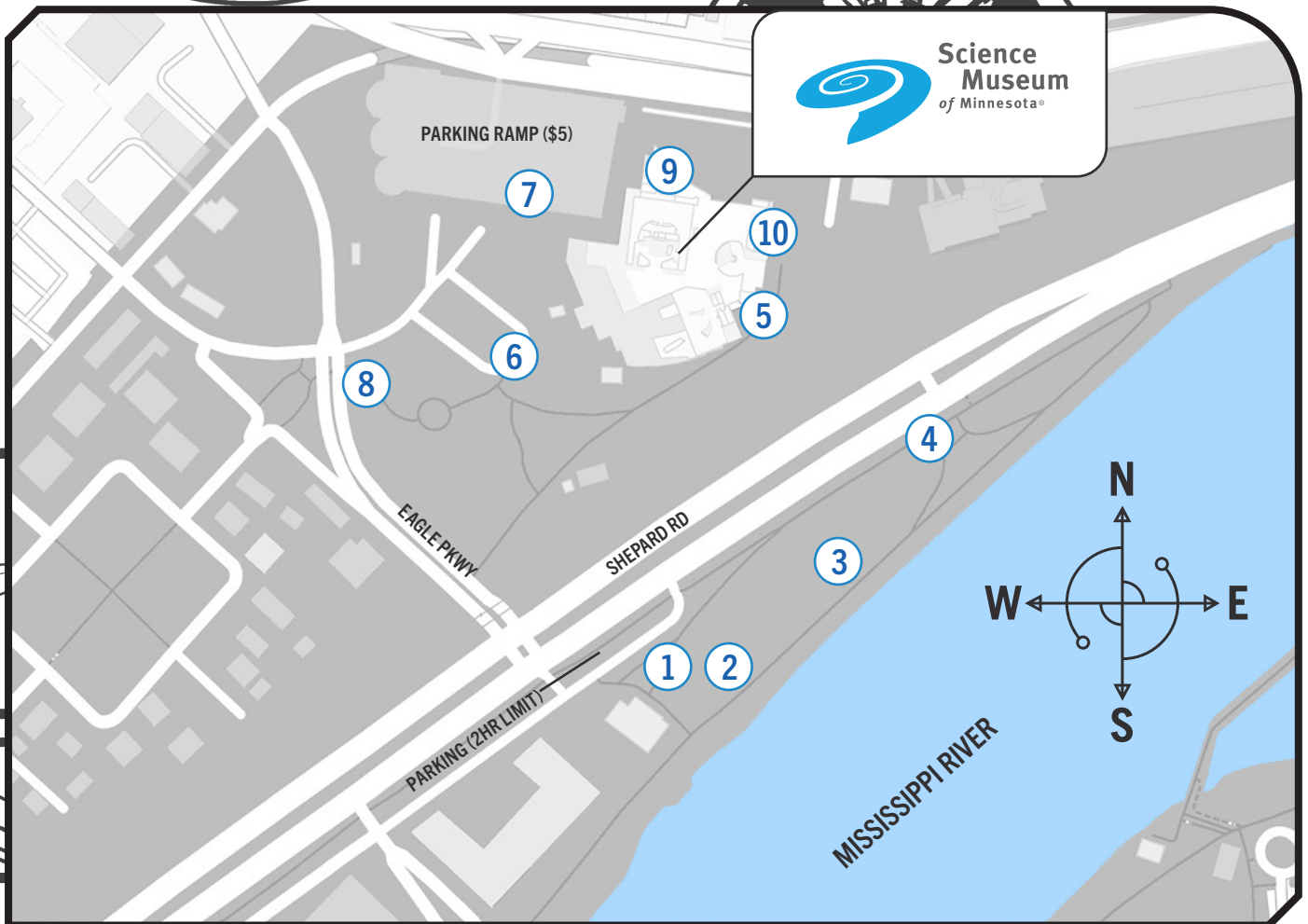

Unlock It! is a fun adventure challenge for all ages. Using your feet, problem-solving ability and teamwork, follow the clues to reveal a set of letters. Once you have all the letters, unscramble them to form the keyword that solves this Unlock It!

Hint: the keyword is a character trait needed to develop our full potential.



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The answers to the clues below reveal key letters needed to solve your *Unlock It!* adventure.

CLUE

Facing the Mississippi River, notice how the water is flowing. Did you know there are over 120 species of fish in the river? Notice the sky. Notice the temperature. Is it windy or calm? Warm or cold? Notice that even in the middle of a capital city, you are surrounded by amazing nature! Look left down the river. How many bridges do you see? What letter does that number correspond to in the alphabet?

CLUE

Notice the four statues of birds, all of which are native to this area. The statues were created by an artist whose name can be found with close examination. Hint: his name may not be on all four statues! What is the first letter of the artist's first name?

CLUE

Using the crosswalk and light, safely cross the street that is one block east of Eagle Pkwy. The name of the street starts and ends with the same vowel. What is it?

CLUE

Follow the walkway to the flight of steps at the corner of the Science Museum. Climb the steps and count them as you climb. How many steps are there? Add the two digits together. What letter does that number correspond to in the alphabet?

CLUE

Find Iggy the iguana. Did you know iguanas use their long, whip-like tails for defense against predators? Wow! How many claws is Iggy missing? If you spell out that number, what is the last letter?

CLUE

Count the number of solar panels in the top row. How many are there? Spell out that number, and use the first letter of the second word.

CLUE

Find the sign about the Oak Savanna. In the scientific name for the Eastern Red Cedar, what is the first letter of its second word?

CLUE

There are four panels welcoming you on the front of the Science Museum of Minnesota. Who do they want you to see in science?

CLUE

At the lookout, find the sign telling you what kind of park the Science Museum is in. The word you just wrote down has the same number of letters as your keyword!
