- **Celebrating 117 Summers:** 2025 marks the 117th summer of Camp Icaghowan, a testament to our community's enduring impact and evolving tradition of excellence in outdoor youth development.
- **Pioneer Point Upgrades & Staff Training**: The Pioneer Point platform tent area received a full upgrade, enhancing the camping experience. This summer, staff will continue to expand their skills and training in mental health and social-emotional support, contributing to a safe and successful summer for all campers.
- Scholarship Support & Accessibility: We welcomed a record-breaking 121 campers last year through donor-supported scholarships, with the demand for financial assistance continuing to grow. Rising programmatic and overhead costs to keep camp running affect registration fees, so these scholarship funds are essential to ensuring our programs remain accessible to every family, regardless of financial circumstances.
- Program Growth and Adventure Expansion: Our Islanders program has expanded their kayaking experience
  from five to seven days, allowing campers to explore even further on their Apostle Islands sea-kayaking
  adventure. The age range for this trip has also increased to offer more adventure opportunities for older teens.
- **New Systems and Streamlined Scheduling**: This spring marked a successful shift to a new CRM system and the announcement of a shortened camp schedule for summer (from six days to five days). These changes support operational efficiency without sacrificing the quality of camper experiences, programs, or traditions.

It took some time for his parents to adjust to "camp life," and he was so excited to share this place with them. His excitement radiated, and his family eventually became actively engaged in songs and activities. The camper was thrilled about building this connection with his family, exclaiming, "This is MY camp!" They have since signed up for other programs and experiences and continue to engage with us.
