- Growing Minds, Growing Spaces: DayCroix continues to serve as the home of our Little Seeds program, a
 nature-based preschool offering incredible support for kids and families in the surrounding Hudson community.
 We're excited to break ground on a new pavilion that will give DayCroix campers and Little Seeds participants a
 dedicated shelter during their farm rotations.
- Where Retreats, Weddings & Wool Meet: Not only do our overnight programs continue to thrive in popularity, but our community group offerings that take place on site in our overnight camp spaces also continue to grow, welcoming everything from traditional school groups and weddings to unique retreats like knitting camps. The variety of experiences our spaces support is a testament to the community's trust and interest, as well as our programming adaptability.
- Partnership Power Supporting Camp Improvements: We have a fantastic ongoing partnership with a company called Philips Medisize where they fund a \$10,000 annual project with the help of volunteers. This year, they will be helping us rebuild our "low initiatives" elements to support fun and engaging teambuilding activities for campers.
- From Farm to Community Nourishing with Purpose: Our farm continues to be a powerful resource for education and food security. With high tunnels enabling vegetable harvests from April through November—even during cold months—we donate fresh, chemical-free produce through partners like River Valley Charities. These donations often happen within a day of harvest, reaching those who need it most. The farm also serves as an access point for hands-on learning and volunteer involvement, deepening the connection between camp and the broader community.
