- **New Program Addition:** Last year, we introduced a new six-day hiking trip, which was a hit with campers and staff alike! We look forward to offering this program again this summer.
- Seasonal Programming Successes: Both Family Camp weekends we hosted in 2024—over Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends—were fully booked, reflecting strong community interest in this seasonal, all-ages programming. Additionally, about 100 participants attended our Adult Winter Camp in February—much fun was had by all!
- **High-Demand Activities:** Last summer's newspaper activity was very popular, so our team plans to grow it further this year. Also, due to significant interest and talent among campers, we've scheduled a third 10-day Lake Superior trip—called 100/100—for our skilled sailors. There's excitement building around this year's surprise "Special Day" themes as well.
- Longer Teen Stays and Wilderness Growth: An increasing number of teens are attending longer camp stays (three-four weeks) and joining bridge sessions and wilderness trips. They're finding meaningful connections and growth through outdoor experiences and time unplugged. Many are embracing challenges and the chance to build a strong camp community together.
- Camperships Made Possible by Donors: Our Annual Fund remains critical in supporting Warren's operations and ensuring that cost is never a barrier to participation. Thanks to the ongoing generosity of our amazing donors (like you!), we continue to offer camperships to families in need without affecting our operating budget. This consistent support has allowed our programs to remain accessible and inclusive year after year.

- **Mission Moment:** Recently, we had several community members join us in hands-on work to keep our forest healthy and reduce the risk of forest fires. This group is made up of volunteers who have experienced the impact of camp as former participants and come back year after year to keep camp ready for today's campers. Forest thinning is difficult work, and Eveleth's cold spring weather makes their dedication even more amazing!
