# **WELCOMING NEW LEADERSHIP**

Last year, we welcomed a new Executive Director (that's me!), as well as a new Program Director, Clara Pena-Hansen, and Canoe Master, Tom Grant, to our team. Their passion and expertise have already had a profound impact on our community, enhancing the camper experience and strengthening our programs.

#### JOE SMITH ENDOWMENT SUCCESS

Our community's generosity was on full display as the **Joe Smith Endowment** soared past its initial goal of \$25,000 to **over \$60,000**! This fund will provide sustained support for Widji's programs and help future generations experience the wilderness in meaningful ways.

# **LOOKING AHEAD: WHAT'S IN STORE FOR SUMMER**

This summer promises to be one of growth, learning, and adventure, with exciting initiatives that deepen our campers' experiences, including:

- **Specialized wildfire management training** to enhance our team's preparedness and environmental stewardship, fueled by **Brent Saxton's leadership** as our Wilderness Program Director.
- **Growing Community Council engagement**, giving campers a voice in shaping their experiences and fostering leadership skills.
- **Expanded backpacking opportunities**, building on our successful co-led Widji Trips model with additional advanced backpacking adventure offerings.

### PROGRAMMATIC GROWTH THAT MATTERS

Thanks in large part to your support and that of other donors, we continue to expand key programs and initiatives that connect more people to the Widji experience, such as our:

- Outdoor Learning Program (OLP), led by Program Director Henry Hark, which maintains a full calendar and receives
  consistently positive feedback, continuing to welcome participants from 4th graders to seniors, engaging them in
  outdoor education, skiing, and environmental stewardship.
- BOLD & GOLD Internship Program, which continues to draw a high number of applicants (with 25+ candidates applying for just six spots!) and aims to foster diversity and inclusion across all that we do, reflecting the broader community we serve.
- Land and Water Acknowledgment, which we are currently revisiting and revitalizing, is being increasingly utilized to inspire environmental stewardship and respect within our community of staff and campers.
